- The Deputy Government Archivist managed to attend the training on nomination to the Memory of the World in Fiji in October of 2016.
- Also attended the PARBICA workshop on the Memory of the World in Fiji on September of 2017 during the PARBICA 17 Conference in Suva.
- Meet with UNESCO Solomons of the possibility of setting up a National Committee of MOW.
- MOW activity plan for 2017 was having an awareness workshop on the Memory of World to identify heritage organizations or memory houses/institutions so that a National Committee on the Memory of the World can be set up. The plan was not carried out.
- In August of 2017, the National Archives of the Solomon Islands managed to submit its nomination to MOWCAP.

- The National Archives of Solomon Islands is informed of the MOW activities through its links with the PARBICA
